## PARIKSHA PARV 6.0

a) The campaign involves live streaming sessions on Facebook/Twitter/YouTube with renowned experts, psychologists and motivational speakers through all NCPCR's social media accounts and Doordarshan. It also includes radio spots and social media campaign for creating awareness and reach among children, teachers and parents. The dates for the streaming will be informed after Hon'ble Prime Minister's Pariksha Pe Charcha 2024. It is requested to encourage students to attend these sessions.

b) Working on children's Right to Participation the Commission plans to involve more children in this program. For this small audio-video messages from students on the theme of Exam Warriors will be invited through NCPCR website (link http://parikshanarv.in).

c) The link will be live from 01/02/2024 to 20/02/2024 for children/students of classes 6 to 12\* who will upload audio-video messages of about 60 seconds. The schools/teachers shall ensure that the videos are uploaded with full parental consent and with complete regard to child's physical as well as online safety.

In the message, children can talk about their experiences during exams go-to routines for relaxation etc. and their point of view on Pariksha Pe Charcha Programme that how it aims to transform stress into success, enabling Exam Warriors to ace exams with a smile. Few pointers for the children that they can follow while making the videos are:

The video can be in any language (Hindi, English, and other Regional languages).

They should start the video with introducing themselves- stating their age, standard and school name. The children can use creative ways to put forward their ideas and experiences. Through display of these messages on National platform, we aim to reach as many children of the country as possible so as to support them during exams and promote positive mental health through messages of fellow children/students. The participating children will be issued -certificate and the selected videos shall be promoted through NCPCR's social media channels. Also, the selected children will be invited to be a part of NCPCR's Foundation Day celebrations.

d) Similarly, parents of children, especially mothers can also upload their videos on the subject. The District Education Officers shall encourage and ensure the participation of mothers/parents by passing necessary orders through School Management Committees (SMCs) and Parents Teachers Associations (PTAs).

e) District-and State-level programmes sensitization-cum-orientation programmes are being organized covering different States/UTs, The programme is intended to sensitize parents and teachers through School Management Committees (SMCs), and Parents Teachers Associations (PTAs). These programmes will be scheduled after Hon'ble Prime Minister's Pariksha Pe Charcha, 2024. The details of these programmes shall also be shared in the due course.

f) An online quiz for children will be organized through Commission's website (link https://examwarriorsquiz.nepcrweb.in/). The link shall be made live from 01.02.2024 onwards. It will containmultiple choice questions based on the chapters in the book-Exum Warriors. An e-certificate will be generated at the end of the quiz. Also, the selected children will be invited to be a part of NCPCR's Foundation Day celebrations.

The Commission has also created a network of qualified and trained Experts/Counsellors for providing psycho- social support to the children through tele counselling - **SAMVEDNA** (18001212830) to address the stress, anxiety, fear and other psycho-social issues experienced by children during the examination period. It is therefore requested to circulate the toll-free number(18001212830) among children for them to seek help as and when required.
